"Whom Say Ye That I Am?"

Mark 8:29

"God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved" (John 3:16, 17).

Do you know God's Son? The Bible, God's personal message to us, gives more than 120 different names for Him. In Luke 1:30, 31, 35 we read that the angel Gabriel told Jesus' mother Mary, "Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. The Holy Spirit shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God."

When Jesus lived on the earth many years ago, He taught in many different places. On one occasion when Jesus was in the northern area of Palestine with His disciples, He provided plenty of food for about 4000 people from 7 loaves of

that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Because Jesus is the Saviour of the world, coming from the glories of heaven to the earth to die on the cross, God had honored Him. "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:9-11). Read Romans 14:11, 12.

Jesus our Saviour is the remedy for the sin borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows. . . He was wounded for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. . . and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all" (Isaiah 53:4-6). See 1 Peter 2:24 and Ephesians 1:7.

An understanding of who Jesus is, is brought about by allowing Him to have complete control in your life His purpose for coming to fulfill every area of your life. Permit Jesus to fulfill by allowing Him to be your Saviour and Lord. The disciple Thomas said to Jesus, "My Lord and my God" (John 20:28).

After you become a Christian, the Holy Spirit will help you live the life of obedience to God. The Holy Spirit will give you an understanding which gives you a rock-solid faith. John 16:12-14. This level of faith is far beyond knowing Jesus in a flesh and blood relationship.

As you continue to feed on the Word of God and grow in your Christian faith, you will learn more about Jesus. The way to learn more of Him is to read the first four books of the New Testament, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, as a beginning. The Apostle John wrote near the end of His gospel, "These (words) are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name" (John 20:31).

Who is Jesus? He is the Son of God and God the Son. And He is the Saviour of the world. If you are a Christian, He is your best friend. But you must allow Him to be your Lord. There are many ways that people would try to avoid taking Jesus as their Lord and still have eternal life and heaven. But we read in Romans 10:13, "Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Again in Romans 10 we have this, "If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart
